

Returning to Face to Face Scouting



Below is an outline of our controls that were outlined in official risk assessment approved by our governing body, we will require all members to understand these and sign the declaration which can be found online. If you would like to see the full risk assessment, please feel free to contact us.



Limited access

Our Meeting place will be limited to members only (parents will not be able to enter the hall), collection and drop off will need to be done via alternative entrance and one-way system. New entrance will be fire door located on the end of the main



Limited Section Sizes

Sections will be limited to 15 young people and 5 adult leaders, this will assist with social distancing and controlling the hygiene standards required. Alternative section meetings will be arranged if required.



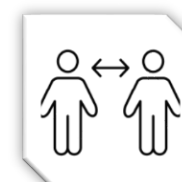
Track & Trace Information

As part of the return requirements we will need to make sure the contact information we hold is correct for members. If the need arises sections may close for a 14 day window to enable suitable isolation. Those over 16 years old will be required to scan building QR code when possible (have smart phone).



Improved Hygiene

Hand sanitizer will be available for use at various control points, members will be expected to use these facilities when entering and exiting the hall and before and after using the toilet facilities. Also, we may ask members to do so during the evening as appropriate. Surface and touch points will be cleaned at start and end of sessions and during where appropriate.



Social Distancing

During evenings we ask all members where possible to maintain a social distance of 2m from both each other and members of the leader team. If first aid is required, then face coverings and gloves will be used. Our program will reflect this measure.



Face Coverings

During evenings face coverings will be worn by the leader teams, unless delivering instruction/running activity. Also due to the age range both Scout and Explorer sections are required to wear suitable face coverings.
